Thanks also goes out to the Utah Gun Club Directors for their efforts in hosting ATA shoots and I strongly encourage everyone to support these clubs and their shoots. Without the work of these directors, the USTA would not have such a full shoot schedule throughout the summer.

Our advertisers are part of the reason we can provide the best trophy package possible and we'd like to thank those who have sponsored an event and/or advertised in our program. Everyone is asked to support these local businesses.

We'd like to thank Browning for again generously donating a BT-99. Be sure to buy a ticket *from any USTA Officer* for a chance to win! Tickets are \$20 each or six for \$100. Proceeds from raffle ticket sales will go toward a ladies and youth Annie shoot Friday night. *To participate, entrants must shoot at least one event at the 2024 State Shoot.*

This year we are offering subjunior and junior reduced target prices of \$34 per event. However, those wishing to play options will be charged full price.

This year classification will be on beginning HOA average for the current target year. Shooters with less than 500 targets in the current target year will be bumped up a class. Classification will be based on the following system:

94% and over	AAA
88% and under 94%	AA
86% and under 88%	A
84% and under 86%	B
81% and under 84%	C
Under 81%	D

Composite averages are figured by adding the shooter's singles, handicap and doubles averages together, then dividing by three. The hope with this option is to have a fairer system of classification for the HOA and HAA. Awards will be paid out to the high composite average in each class, paid high gun, events 1-11.

Please make plans to attend the annual meeting Saturday, June 22, on the patio after the first 100 singles. We will be voting for USTA officers and presenting State Team awards.

Thank you, again, for your ongoing support of the Utah State Shoot and USTA. Feel free to contact a USTA Officer if you have any questions or concerns.

HANDICAPPING – SQUADDING – CASHIERING - TROPHIES

Handicapping, squadding, and cashiering will open Tuesday, June 18, from 1:00–7:00 pm, then Wednesday, June 19, through Sunday, June 23, from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. You **must** have an **up-to-date** average card with you to get handicapped. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Starting Thursday, June 20, trophies will be handed out daily from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm

GENERAL INFORMATION

The shoot management is composed of the USTA officers and board of directors. ATA rules will govern this shoot.

- The 2024 Utah State Shoot will consist of 1,300 targets shot on the days of June 19-23, 2024
- Fluorescent orange dome (pitch) White Flyer targets will be thrown
- Doubles will be shot in two 25 pair subevents
- Singles and handicap events will be shot 25 birds to a house
- All preliminary and class singles and doubles events will be carried over to next like event. Singles and doubles championship events will be shot off
- All preliminary and class handicap events will be carried over unless at least one shooter earns yardage, then there will be a shoot off that evening unless mutually agreed upon by all shooters to carry over. Handicap championship will be shot off
- Shoot off participants must check in within 10 minutes of the shoot off call
- Shooters winning or tying for a shoot off in any singles or doubles event in this program will be advanced at least one class for the next event
- Any shooter earning yardage in handicap events must report to the squadding committee for yardage punch and possible squad changes before the next similar event
- Errors in scores must be changed before moving posts or they become final
- There shall be no more than TWO (2) yards difference between adjacent shooters and will follow ATA standard rules for yardage separations on squads
- All ATA shooters are invited to attend the UTAH STATE SHOOT
- Selling ammunition, reloading supplies, etc., on the grounds of Spanish Fork Gun Club is strictly prohibited. Ammunition will be available in the clubhouse based on availability. Reloads must meet the requirements set forth by the ATA and may be subject to inspection by an ATA official
- All shooters will be charged a USTA daily fee of \$3.00 and an ATA daily fee of \$4.00
- The management reserves the right to refuse entry or disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner
- A fee of \$2.00 per post will be charged at the time of pre-squadding starting March 14 at 8 a.m. on Presquad.com. **PLEASE NOTE: Once you have missed your first presquadded event, you will be removed from all other presquadded events unless you contact us in advance.**
- Please watch your squad number. You will have 5 minutes to take your position with your squad or they will start without you. Re-squad fees charged at cashier's discretion

USTA MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The annual membership meeting will be held on the patio at Spanish Fork Gun Club Saturday, June 22, after the first 100 singles. Business will be conducted as follows:

- Presentation of the 2023 Utah State Team, Rookie of the Year, and other special awards
- Vote for the 2024-2025 USTA officers (***Nominations should be submitted to the Secretary by Friday, June 21, at 5 p.m. These names will appear on a pre-printed ballot. Other nominations can be added at the USTA annual membership meeting prior to voting.***)
- Vote for the USTA/ATA delegate and alternate delegate
- Other business, as directed by the board of directors
- Announcement of the 2025 Utah State Shoot location

All Utah shooters are encouraged to attend and vote. You must have a current ATA average card or lifetime membership card present to vote. NO EXCEPTIONS. Voting will take place after the meeting.

TARGET REQUIREMENT PENALTY

- Shooters who do not have a combined total of 1,000 *singles* targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous target year will be advanced at least one class at the discretion of the classification committee. Shooters without an established average will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.
- Shooters who do not have a combined total of 1,000 handicap targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous target year will be assigned to the **23 YARD LINE** or their regular handicap yardage, whichever is greater.
- Shooters who do not have a combined total of 1,000 *doubles* targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous target year will be advanced at least one class at the discretion of the classification committee. Shooters without an established average will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher at the discretion of the classification committee.

*****ONCE AN EVENT HAS STARTED, THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS*****

SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

All Special Category Shooters must declare their special category **at the time of classification** if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. If a classification error is discovered **BEFORE** the close of an event, the error shall be corrected for that event and all subsequent events. If an error is discovered **AFTER** an event is closed, all corrections shall be made for subsequent events only. In either case, all previous events the shooter shot in will be in the "Open Category". Either case may or may not affect the shooters eligibility for the HOA and HAA, depending on when the error was corrected.

All age-based categories are established on the shooter's birthday

ATA POLICY ON FALLBACK RULES WILL APPLY TO ALL EVENTS

The USTA will consider Special Category Championship trophies **superior** to Class Championship trophies. The intent of the USTA regarding the winning of trophies is no shooter may win more than one trophy per event.

ANY SHOOTER WINNING \$600 OR MORE IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THEIR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER BEFORE ANY CHECKS WILL BE MAILED

Please provide your SSN when you classify. We will not mail checks if you don't.

1000 BIRD TEAM RACE: UTAH RESIDENTS ONLY

A 5-person team race will be held concurrently with the Championship Singles on Saturday. Any 5 Utah ATA shooters may form a team. Teams must be signed up prior to the beginning of **EVENT #10**. \$500 will be split 60/40 to the first and second place teams. There is no charge to enter.

2-IN-A-FAMILY RACE

A 2-in-a-family race will be held concurrently with the Championship Singles on Saturday. Any 2 family members may form a team. Teams must be signed up prior to the beginning of **EVENT #10**. Trophies will be awarded to in-state and out-of-state winners.

UTAH GUN CLUB WOBBLE CHALLENGE

Any 5 ATA members may form a team that will shoot one 25-bird round from the 24 yard line. One shot per bird, 25 targets per person. Cost is \$35 per team (\$7/round). Sign up begins Friday at the trophy window from 11 am – 3 pm; contest begins immediately after last event of the day. Pays first

and second place teams 60/40 of total entries. Targets are donated by the USTA. **Wobble rules:** Unless the target is broken, you must shoot the target that comes out; if not, it will be considered a loss. Five shots per post.

ATA HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTION AWARDS Event #12 Utah State Handicap Championship

The \$15 fee for this award is a tax-deductible donation to the ATA Hall of Fame. The purpose of this donation is to further the ATA Hall of Fame Expansion Program. All donors will qualify for the ATA Hall of Fame awards. Your entry card will show this contribution and will be your receipt. The ATA Hall of Fame will retain 50% of the donation while the remainder will constitute the portion to be awarded. Awards will be paid out in 4 Lewis Classes, 60/40 in each class, on Event #12.

The Trapshooting Hall of Fame maintains a museum at the home grounds in Sparta, Illinois, and provides a research library for the history of our sport. It also awards college scholarships and conducts a youth program to promote the future of trapshooting. We encourage you to participate and support its various activities.

MEN'S FIRST AND SECOND TEAM (18-64 years old)

- Singles.....2,000
- Handicap.....2,000
- Doubles.....2,000
- Utah State Shoot Championship Events
- 600 singles, 600 handicap, and 600 doubles of the State Team Requirement must be shot from 6 different USTA clubs. You must shoot at least 100 singles, 100 handicap, and 100 doubles at each club to count the club.

SPECIAL CATEGORY TEAMS (Lady, Veteran and Rookie of the Year)

All special category shooters will be determined by category selection at your first registered shoot of the target year. For example, if a shooter qualifies for two State Team categories such as Junior and Lady, whichever category is selected at the first shoot will be the State Team that you will qualify for. Otherwise, State Team category will be determined by age.

- Singles.....2,000
- Handicap.....2,000
- Doubles.....2,000
- Utah State Shoot Championship Events
- 600 singles, 600 handicap, and 600 doubles of the State Team Requirement must be shot from 6 different USTA clubs. You must shoot at least 100 singles, 100 handicap, and 100 doubles at each club to count the club.

The Rookie of the Year candidate will be required to submit a resume to the USTA Secretary on or before January 1 following the target year being applied for. Resumes will be reviewed by the USTA Board of Directors.

SPECIAL CATEGORY TEAMS (Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub-junior)

- Singles.....1,800
- Handicap.....1,800
- Doubles.....1,200
- Utah State Shoot Championship Events
- 600 singles, 600 handicap, and 600 doubles of the State Team Requirement must be shot from 6 different USTA clubs. You must shoot at least 100 singles, 100 handicap, and 100 doubles at each club to count the club.

All members of any Utah State Team must be in good standing with the ATA/USTA during the target year they are named a team member. All registered targets, marathon and otherwise, will count toward all State Team requirements for the purpose of determining averages only. Marathon targets will not count towards a club requirement. A marathon target is defined as a group of targets provided by a club in quantities to be an endurance contest and not a competition. A shooter must be a resident of the State of Utah at least six months before the State Shoot to qualify for the team.
